Conditions of Participation

Welcome to Academic Assessment Services (AAS) online testing for schools! To ensure a smooth testing process, it's crucial to understand and follow these guidelines.

Online testing is to be conducted on campus under the supervision of authorised school staff. To maintain test integrity, please ensure that all necessary security measures are in place.

School Principal agreement

The School Principal is required to sign and submit an agreement, which serves to:

- Confirm both validity of the test data and the confidentiality of the test materials and processes.
- Provide consent for the collection of personal information on behalf of the students.
- Ensure no assistance is provided during the examination.
- Prohibit copies, storage or sharing of test questions in any form.

Secure testing environment

The online examination will be provided through a **locked-down browser** that restricts access to external websites, applications, or aids, such as spell checkers.

In particular instances when there is an absence of school staff for supervision, students may require a webcam-equipped computer to capture their photo and record the exam session for identity verification. The school's acceptance of this condition is necessary for certain tests to proceed, with a guarantee from AAS staff that any recordings will be promptly deleted after confirming the student's identity. No images of students will be used for any purpose other than ensuring the validity of the online examination.

School responsibilities

At least 7 days before the scheduled test day:

- AAS will provide login details and individual passwords to the school's main contact.
- School staff are responsible for assisting students in checking the technical readiness of their resources.
- Students must complete a short preparation exercise (approximately 10-15 minutes) and login to familiarise themselves with the online testing process and check for any technical difficulties.
- AAS is unable to generate logins or include extra students in the online testing system within **48 hours** of the examination day.

It is highly recommended that this preparation test is completed before the scheduled test day. If any technical difficulties arise, please communicate them directly to AAS as soon as possible to ensure resolution before testing begins.

If the **NAPLAN online testing software** or an older version of the AAS Safe Exam Browser has been downloaded previously, please uninstall before downloading the new version of the AAS Safe Exam Browser.

Note: AAS will not be held responsible for technical issues with the student's computer, internet connection, or the user's lack of technological skills on the day of testing. If the technical requirements are not met, students will not be permitted to participate.

Examination day

On the day of the exam:

- Students will complete two sessions:
 - **Session One** includes General Ability, Reading Comprehension and Spelling (Spelling is not tested for Scholarship examinations), followed by a recess break (20 minutes).
 - **Session Two** includes Mathematics and Written Expression.
- All assessments are multiple-choice and Written Expression must be **typed**.
- Students must take the tests at the scheduled time, and additional time will not be permitted.
- Once testing begins, students should follow the prompts to complete each section.

Online Testing Instructions

This guide outlines the installation process for your School's IT department and the online testing process for School staff monitoring the exam.



Install the Safe Exam Browser for Windows or macOS operating systems.

Note: The Safe Exam Browser (SEB) is not supported on iPads or Chromebooks.

If the **NAPLAN online testing software** or an older version of the AAS Safe Exam Browser has been downloaded previously, please uninstall before downloading the new version of the AAS Safe Exam Browser.



View your tests list

Prior to the examination day, students will have access to a short preparation test (10-15 minutes). This is to ensure that the SEB has been installed successfully and students become familiar with the process.


On the examination day, students will have a list of tests allocated to them. When each test is available the **Start Test** button will appear. If the test is showing as **Waiting**, the student must wait until the allocated time and previous test is submitted.





The following screenshots demonstrate the steps and features of online testing once a test has commenced.






Key:

- The time remaining will appear on the top of the screen.
- Go through the questions by clicking Next.
- Click on **Test Review** to view questions you have either: answered or have not answered, or questions that have been marked as review. (See step 8 on the next page)
- Students in Year 8 and above can use a calculator for the Mathematics Placement exam. There are two different calculator modes: Math and Norm. Calculators are not permitted for Scholarship exams.
- There is a notepad available to write any working out.
- Click on Test Review to view questions you have either: answered or have not answered, or questions that have been marked for review. (See step 8 on the next page)
- Questions you have answered will appear green.




The test review list can be viewed at anytime during the exam. Students will be prompted to check the review list again at the end of the test before submitting.


Questions marked for review might include items that students are uncertain about and wish to revisit for later response.





After the final question in the test, click next. Students will then be asked to either view the test review list or submit test.







After submitting each test, students will then land on your tests page to start the next test or they will need to wait until it is available.
